

Colour Pallets Table Runner



Design idea from the farm shop where painted vegetable pallets were piled high in the car park.

Finished size 12" x 49"

You Need:

4 Oakshott Fat Eighths Have fun choosing your colours

15" x 54" backing fabric and 3³/₄ yards of 2" strips for binding

Cutting out:

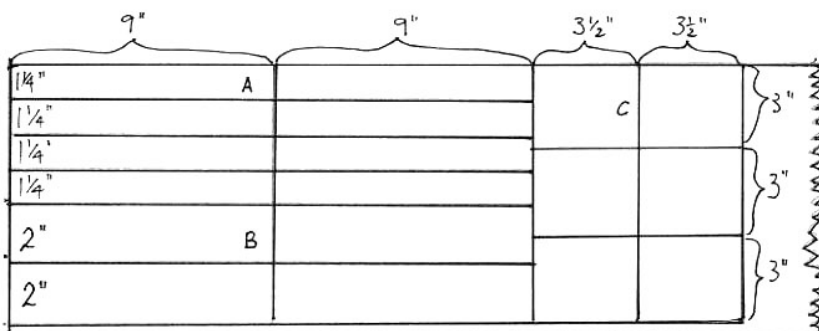
First spray your fabric with water and iron to remove the creases.

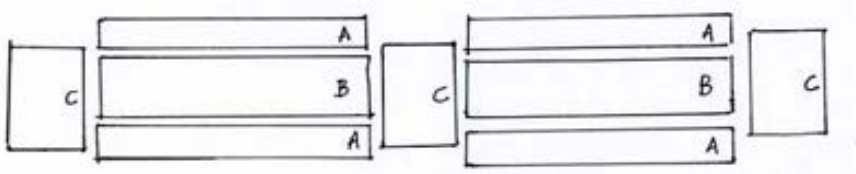
No need to pre-wash as Oakshott is colourfast.

Layer your fabrics.

Trim very narrowly along one long edge and the short ends opposite the selvedge.

Cut as diagram:





Lay out your 8 blocks like this:

A & C pieces are from the same fabric and B are in a contrast.

Join your blocks:

Join A to B and add the second A twice to make the centre panels then join to C pieces.

Arrange your blocks and join together.

Layer with wadding and backing and quilt. I used close lines of matchstick quilting adding to the texture of the piece. I finished my edges with double fold French binding cut 2" wide, pressed in half and stitched to the back of the quilt, folded to the front and machined into place. As I was short of this particular fabric I added in scraps of colour left over from the blocks to lengthen it!
